hereby file Criminal charges for manslaughter or murder against unknown police officers in the death of Oury Jalloh .

Oury Jalloh, on 7th January 2005 in cell no. 5 of the Dessau police station at 25 Wolfgangstr., was affixed by his hands and feet to a flame-retardant

mattress, where he burned beyond recognition.

Despite numerous clues and conclusive investigation results to the contrary, both the public prosecutor's office of Dessau-Roßlau as well as the two chambers of the district courts in Dessau and Magdeburg consistently insist that Oury Jalloh ignited the fire himself.

The public prosecutor has continually refused further investigation into this case as a potential homicide, despite new evidence, on the grounds that there were no new facts suggesting that third parties may have gained access to the cell no. 5.

As part of the evaluation of an independent fire report, commissioned by the Initiative in Remembrance of Oury Jalloh e.V., crucial new evidence has been revealed that contradicts the possibility of the hypothesized self-ignition.

This results in the need for a new investigative inquiry and clarification regarding the outbreak and course of the fire in cell no. 5.

We turn to you, firstly, because the present case deals with a particularly serious crime with respect to internal security and the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Germany, since the yet-to-be-determined perpetrators must necessarily be executive officers of the Federal State of Saxony-Anhalt.

Secondly, the case of Oury Jalloh was heard over a total of four years in two different jury trials in Saxony-Anhalt, whereby approval was never granted for adequate reconstruction of the origin and course of the fire in cell no. 5.

The police, prosecutorial and judicial investigative bodies of Saxony-Anhalt have, for the past nine years and despite instructions from the highest court, boycotted a lawful investigation of the case. The demand for an unreserved clarification of the circumstances of Oury Jalloh's death seems unworkable in any other jurisdiction of the state authorities in Saxony-Anhalt.

On the following pages you will find a collection of crucial evidence that points far beyond the initial suspicion of third party involvement in Oury Jalloh's death and is pivotal for carrying out a thorough investigation.
